

HOLYHEAD LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No7/2009.

HOLYHEAD PORT CONTROL.

1. Holyhead Port Control (call sign 'Holyhead Port Control'), which is situated on Admiralty Pier, maintains a monitoring watch on VHF channel 14 and a listening watch on VHF channel 16. The working channel for the Port is VHF channel 14.
2. Messages relating to the movement of vessels, the safety of vessels or persons and emergencies of any nature can be accepted.
3. All vessels should give 24 hours notice of ETA by contacting Port Control via their agents, or by email: portcontrol@stenaline.com, telephone: 01407 606700 or fax: 01407 606622.
4. All ferries must contact Port Control 1 hour before arrival, or as soon as is practicable, and give their ETA at Point Victor (1.5 miles from the breakwater) and ETA alongside, whether carrying Dangerous Goods and report any defects.
5. All ferries must, additionally, contact Port Control 3 miles from the Breakwater to request permission to enter the port.
6. All non-ferry vessels must contact Port Control 1 hour before arrival to give their ETA on the Breakwater, or where applicable, the Pilot Boarding Point, and ETA alongside, whether carrying Dangerous Goods and report any defects.
7. All non-ferry vessels must contact Port Control 3 miles from the Breakwater to request permission to enter the port.
8. All vessels wishing to depart or manoeuvre within Harbour Limits must contact Port Control 10 minutes before ETD.

Vessels operating within Harbour Limits must maintain a listening watch on VHF channel 14.
